


We want to repeat again today the experience of Chiara and her first companions when they were in Trent, 'colouring' our cities with love.


If God is with us, one city is too little.

"Let's love, love, love: so that at the end of our life we won't regret the fact that we have loved too little!"












Seek out its spiritual head,

go with your friends to see him.
Present your plans to him, (winning over the young people of the city) and if he does not consent, do not take even a step, for otherwise you will ruin everything.

If he advises you and offers you some guidelines accept them as a command and make them an order for you and for your friends.

Assure him of your loyalty for Christ has commanded it, and offer to help him – with your spiritual contribution – in his heavy responsibility.

Then look for the poorest, the destitute, the forsaken, the orphans, the prisoners.


Run with your friends to visit Christ in them, to comfort them, to reveal to them that the love of God is close to them and watches over them.



If someone is hungry, bring food to that person, and if someone is naked give him clothes.

If you have no clothing or food, ask for them from the Eternal Father with faith because they are necessary for his Son Christ, who you wish to serve in every human being. And he, God will hear you.

Loaded with all these goods go through the streets, **go up into attics and down into cellars,** seek out Christ in public and private places, at the stations, along the railways, in the slums, and caress him above all with your smile.

While you are gladdening the Lord in your brothers and sisters, God will take care to fill you and your friends with heavenly gifts (with joy).


SHARE THESE WITH ONE ANOTHER,

Keep going.








If others, having got to know your life and seen with their own eyes the gifts you have (received from heaven),

Base what you say on the Gospel which you and your group have absorbed, as your first, safe, inexhaustible, eternal source.

You can read it at leisure...



I greet you all.






Having consoled, helped, enlightened, made happy, those who were the dregs of society, you have laid the foundations of the building of the new city.

Let your Task Force be at His service and each of you weep with those who weep, rejoice with those who rejoice, constantly share sufferings and joys as well as any sacrifice, without ever ceasing.



Alternate your action with the deepest prayer lifted up by your army in perfect unity so that – through Christ – the greatest glory may be won from that place.

And if the struggle costs, know that there lies the secret of success, and that he who urges you on has paid with his blood.


FORGIVE AND PRAY FOR THOSE WHO THINK ILL OF YOU,


for if you do not forgive, you will not find mercy.





And if suffering consumes you, sing out: "Behold Jesus Forsaken!
Behold my spouse, my friend,
my brother" so that in the hour
of your death the Lord may
say to your soul:
"Arise, and hurry, my friend, my dove,
my fair one, and come away."









Do this for a city until victory, to the point, that is, that good overcomes evil and Christ through us can repeat:

"I have overcome the world."



But with a God who visits you in Holy Communion every morning, if you wish, one city is too little. He is the one who has made the stars, who guides the destiny of the ages.

Come to an agreement with him, and aim further: at your country, at everyone's country, at the world.

Let your every breath be for this; for this your every action; for this your resting and your moving. Having reached the other side, you will see that which has most value, and you will find a reward proportionate to your love.

Act in such a way that in that hour you will not have to be sorry for having loved too little.





And so, Gen, it seems to me that this is **your Manifesto**.

In the year two thousand you will be still young, you will be adults.

To a certain extent you will be able to govern the world. You can form it as you want it if you have begun now to change the heart of people.

The structures will change, the boundaries will also change, many things will have a new appearance because the Holy Spirit will help us, but only if from now on as little children you will already have faith in God that he will make use of you to change the heart of people.

And how can you change the heart of people?
We can change it with love.



Well, Gen, let us make a competition with you, the littlest ones, the ones whom I am sure God loves most; the ones whom I too love most, so as to share in this predilection of the heart of Jesus


We shall have a competition between all of us to see who will love most of all.

Chiara Lubich: Il manifesto to the third generation (Message to the gen 3 - 1970)



6x1 is a useful method for living activities effectively with the community. It is a path that reinforces in those who participate in it the ability to become active citizens.



OBSERVE LET'S LOOK AROUND US

- Acquire a broad and conscious vision of the different aspects of the city.
- Discover together the existing problems in the territory.



THINK LET'S SUM UP OUR IDEAS

- Assess the seriousness and urgency of the problems detected.
- Participatively choose the problem on which you plan to intervene with a project.



INVOLVE TOGETHER WE ARE STONGER

- Formulate clearly and precisely the causes and effects of the problem we have identified.
- Involve all those who are sensitive to this issue and figure out how to work together.

6x1 helps plan activities in a way that is consistent with the goals of the group and allows for full participation of every one involved. The whole group gradually develops **a "vision" for working together** in their town or district, enabling them **to identify the real needs of the area where they live and to focus on what could be their specific contribution to resolve them.**



ACT LET'S DIRTY OUR HANDS

- Draw up the objective of our project.
- Precisely describe the timeframe and responsibilities for carrying out the project.



EVALUATE KNOW HOW TO IMPROVE

- Experience the moment of evaluation as an essential part to strengthen the group and as a moment of collective learning.
- Give meaning to every moment lived, even to those that would seem to be failures.



CELEBRATE LET'S REIOICE

- Discover and enhance the contribution that everyone has made to achieving the objectives.
- Share the joy of the results achieved with all those who participated.
